**Main duties and responsibilities:**

To provide assistance during the delivery and ongoing development of the postgraduate certificate programmes, including:

- Marking online activities and critical review submissions; providing appropriate constructive feedback to students.

- Moderation of and contribution to the discussion forums, requesting subject-matter support from speaker and/or Programme Coordinator when required.
- Scrutinising online activities to ensure they are relevant and clear, including in response to concerns raised by students.
- Aid senior staff when commissioning material for online resources and activities.
- Be responsible for relevant sections of the online learning platform and update as required.
- Updating the online resources for the certificate programmes to ensure that the learning material remains current.
- Proofreading any new or updated materials provided by speakers and comparing them to intended learning outcomes for the unit.  
When required, schedule and host synchronous online activities e.g. webinars, in conjunction with the Education team at Woodrow House.
- To contribute to the academic administration of the BSAVA Postgraduate Certificate Awards as requested by the department managers.
